Please provide event details, such as who, what, when, and where, as well as the funds requested. Lafeber Company will be most likely to support additional events that impact broad demographics, including veterinary medical students, college faculty and staff, as well as veterinary health care professionals in the region.

Reduced cost food program

LafeberVet prices are always reduced when compared to retail. Use of the monthly Lafeber Company Student Program **coupon code** further reduces prices, making the final price approximately 65% below retail. The code also provides free shipping.

The coupon code will be disseminated by the student representative. All college personnel are welcome to use this coupon code, including veterinary medical students, house officers, faculty members, and staff. (See *Lafeber Student Program Online* for additional information).

There is a \$20 minimum for coupon code orders.

Lafeber-EmerAid products are offered to the teaching hospital for care of in-house patients

Where applicable, the teaching hospital or affiliated animal care resources, like university wildlife rehabilitation, intensive care, or laboratory facilities, are welcome to utilize an **annual credit**. This credit renews at the beginning of each school year.

Orders are placed online using the points system outlined in the "*Annual Credit Program Online*" PDF. Orders must exceed \$125 in value to achieve free shipping. Smaller hospital service orders can be placed using the monthly coupon code to achieve free shipping.



Student representative compensation

The representative position pays \$60 per month. Co-representatives will share the pay. Representatives will be paid by the automated clearinghouse (ACH) network.

- ☐ A brief Monthly Report of tasks completed is required for compensation.

Complete the form and submit to Dr. Christal Pollock at VetStudents@lafeber.com. You should receive confirmation via email that your report was received within 3 business days.

Reports must be received within 3 months. For instance, a report dated September 2025 should be received by January 1, 2026 at the latest.

- ☐ The Student Program should ideally be active through both fall and spring semesters.

Activities over the summer months are appreciated but not required. Compensation over summer break will only be provided in return for active duty (*see below*).

Student representative duties

1. Disseminate the LafeberVet monthly **coupon code** to college personnel
2. Identify who will be in charge of **hospital service orders** for 2025-2026. If that individual is you, then collect monthly orders using the annual credit.
3. Support Lafeber Company **sponsorship** of your school's exotics club
 - ☐ Submit suggestions for speakers or topics that will be well received by your club.
 - ☐ Facilitate the Lafeber-sponsored speaker(s) or event(s) at your institution.
4. Distribute Lafeber-EmerAid **brochures & samples** during continuing education events
5. Submit a **monthly report on Student Program** to VetStudents@lafeber.com.
 - ☐ Receipt of the monthly report is necessary for compensation.
 - ☐ Please re-send your email if no response is received within 3 business days.
